

## Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)

### What is ACP?

- The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a broadband subsidy program administered by the FCC. Individuals and households may qualify to receive a monthly credit to offset the cost of broadband internet subscriptions.

### What does ACP Cover?

- Each household receives credit of up to \$30/month for broadband services for households (\$75/month for households on tribal lands). If consumer chooses eligible service plan that regularly costs \$30/month or less, consumer will receive that service for free.
- Credits may apply to bundled services that include internet, voice, or text and/or service packages that include equipment like routers, modems, or hotspots. Bundled services may **not** include cable TV.
- Eligible households can also receive a one-time \$100 benefit for devices such as laptops and tablets, if the household contributes between \$10-50 towards the price.

### ACP Eligibility Requirements?

- A household is considered eligible if it meets one of the following qualifications:
  - Income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines
  - At least one household member receives Federal Pell Grant in current award year
  - At least one household member receives [free/reduced lunch/breakfast](#)
  - At least one household member qualifies in certain assistance programs such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline.
  - At least one member of the household participates in a [Tribal specific programs](#).
  - At least one household member qualifies for a service provider's existing low-income program
- Existing outstanding payments to a service provider **do not** disqualify a household's eligibility.

### Registration Process?

- Most Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) recipients will not have to take any action to enroll in ACP. However, households that qualified for EBB due to a substantial loss of income or through a COVID-19 program must requalify.
- Existing Lifeline participants must register to opt-into ACP, but do not need to provide additional documentation.
- New applicants can sign up for ACP by going to [ACPBenefit.org](https://ACPBenefit.org) and submit an application online or by mail to: ACP Support Center PO Box 7081 London, KY 40742. Applicants must provide their full name, date of birth, address and ONE of the following documents: SSN, Tribal Identification Number, Government-Issued ID, Passport, Certificate of U.S Citizenship or Naturalization, Permanent Residence Card or Green Card, Driver's License, or Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) for identity verification purposes.
- A Social Security Number is **not** required for eligibility
