WHAT IS ANTI-BLACKNESS & WHY SHOULD IT MATTER TO ME?

What is anti-Blackness?

Anti-Blackness refers to the behaviors, actions, and attitudes that minimize, marginalize, and devalue Black individuals or those perceived to be Black. Anti-Blackness can be intentional or unintentional, conscious or unconscious, and can be performed by individuals or systems.

Why should anti-Blackness matter to me?

In order to achieve civil and human rights for Asian Americans, we must dismantle the social and racial hierarchy that enshrines whiteness and devalues Blackness. Asian Americans cannot achieve civil and human rights without advocating for the civil and human rights of Black and other marginalized communities.

A Common Misconception: Black-Asian Violence

Anti-Asian violence is driven by white supremacy and racism. Though some high-profile videos paint a different picture, most anti-Asian attacks are <u>not</u> perpetrated by Black individuals (<u>source</u>).
