Muaj kev pab txhais hom lus twg thiab?

Koj tuaj yeem tau txais cov ntaub ntawv pov npav xaiv tsa, daim ntawv teev npe pov npav xaiv tsa, thiab cov ntawv pov npav xaiv tsa uas txhais ua Lus Hmoob. Ntawm koj qhov chaw pov npav, koj kuj tseem tuaj yeem nrhiav cov neeg ua haujlwm pov npav xaiv tsa uas tuaj yeem hais Lus Hmoob tau thiab.

Kuv yuav tau cov ntaub ntawv ua Lus Hmoob li cas?

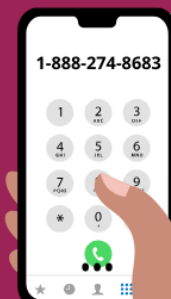

You Have the Right to Language Assistance in Hmong When You Vote

What law gives me the right to language assistance in Hmong?

Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act (VRA) requires certain counties to provide in-language voting materials for communities with many limited English-speaking voters.

What type of language assistance is available?

You can obtain written voter information, voter registration forms, and ballots translated into Hmong. At your voting location, you can also find poll workers who can speak Hmong.

How do I get materials in Hmong?

Contact your elections office and ask them to send you voting materials in Hmong. Find information on how to contact these offices at:

Where can I get a voter registration form?

You can contact your elections office to get a voter registration form and follow the instructions on how to send it to a state or local election office for processing. You can also register online at:

- ◆ U.S. Election Assistance Commission – Register to Vote
- ◆ National Voter Registration Application Form for U.S. Citizens (CHS)

Can I bring someone into the voting booth to help me vote?

Yes. You have the right to bring someone into the voting booth to help you. This person can be a friend, relative, or someone else you trust. It only cannot be your boss or a representative of your labor union.
